Parents of four separate students wrote in to nominate Mrs. Lovell for this award because they have all been so impressed by her teaching and some have even had multiple children go through her class. One parent says that Mrs. Lovell has won many awards because she is such a wonderful teacher and they all said that she is great with teaching and kids. Because Mrs. Lovell is so passionate about reading and instilling a love for reading in her students, she spends hundreds of dollars a year out of her own pocket to purchase books for her students. She plans on using this award to help alleviate some of the personal expenses that have come up as part of her teaching program and to continue buying more reading materials.
